- **ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING**
  - PRIMARY AIM - EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION
  - SPRI BEGINS WEATHERING STUDIES OF SINGLE PLY MEMBRANES

# OCTOBER 1998



- ESTABLISH A FAIR, OBJECTIVE, RATINGS SYSTEM
- BEGIN DETERMINATION OF TEST METHODS
- GOAL FOR 2004: HAVE AN OPERATIONAL ACCREDITATION AND LABELING PROCESS IN PLACE AND HAVE ACTIVE INDUSTRY PARTICIPATION
- ROODVOETS EXPECTATION: 60 TO 100 COMPANIES PARTICIPATING WHEN FULLY OPERATIONAL

1999



- **CRRC EVALUATES TEST METHODS**
- **SPRI WEATHERING TEST SHOW 24% AVERAGE LOSS OF REFLECTIVITY IN ONE YEAR OF OUTDOOR EXPOSURE**

2000



- **CRRC-1 FIRST DRAFT IS PRESENTED**
- **SPRI MEMBERS HAVE SIGNIFICANT INPUT AND SUGGESTED CHANGES**
- **CRRC BEGINS SERIOUS DEBATE ON AGED REQUIREMENTS FOR REFLECTIVE TESTING AND EVALUATION**
- **TO WASH OR NOT TO WASH**

2001



- **CRRC STARTS NEGOTIATIONS WITH WEATHERING FARMS**
- **SPRI STUDIES SHOW THAT DEGRADATION IN REFLECTIVITY OF SINGLE PLY MEMBRANES IS NOT DUE TO UV DEGRADATION, BUT DUE TO SURFACE CONTAMINATION, PRIMARILY BIOLOGICAL GROWTH**

2002



- **CRRC HAS PRODUCT RATING ROLL OUT**
- **SPRI PRESENTS PAPERS ON WEATHERING STUDIES OF AGED SINGLE PLY MEMBRANES**
- **CRRC-1 VERSION 11 IS REVIEWED**
- **SPRI BOD REJECTS DEVELOPING AN ALTERNATIVE SYSTEM SUPPORTS CRRC**
