Validation Testing Program

- Quality assurance mechanism replacing Random Testing in 2025, ensuring:
- Rated product values are accurate
- Products are available
- Ratings haven't gotten "stale" due to changes in test methods, components, or suppliers





Validation Testing Development Process

2023

- Staff begins development
 - Random Testing Working Group Review
 - 1-on-1 calls with Industry
 - CRRC Board and Executive Committee Review
 - CRRC Licensee webinar



Validation Testing Program Details

- Active rated products are:
- required to be validated every 7 years to remain on the Roof Directory
- sent directly to a lab selected by CRRC
- are tested according to the current test method
- given two chances to pass VT

Validation Testing Program Costs

- CRRC pays for product testing under VT
- Increased testing costs covered by product renewal fee increase

Test Farms are now required to provide photos upon exposure placement ("Initial" photos)






Climatic Conditions of Test Farm Sites

Ohio (cold/temperate)




"Incorrectly Exposed" Term and Definition

- New term "Incorrectly Exposed" and its definition added to the Program Manuals
- Procedure for handling specimens that are unusable for aged testing updated to include "Incorrectly Exposed Specimens"





Wall Product Specified Mounting




- Wall specimens are mounted in an offset rack to minimize cross-contamination from dripping
- Wall specimens that are 3 inches x 10 inches do not fit on offset racks
- 10-inch specimens are mounted on only the top row of non-offset racks

- Proposed updates to other CRRC documents may still be presented at other times of the year










Portal Updates - Reporting Tools





Portal Updates - Invoicing Section






Portal Updates - Validation Testing Portal Integration






2023 EOY Wall Program Finances




Member Geographic Distribution: Global






Member Geographic Distribution: USA
